“I Called Everywhere!”

The true Christmas story never grows old. Shepherds. Wise men. Angels. Mary and Joseph searching for shelter in Bethlehem and finding “no room in the inn...”

The family takes shelter in a stable where the Prince of Peace is born.

But for many families, like Cinda’s, even the lowliest shelter is sometimes elusive.

Back in January of 2009, Cinda lost her job. Eventually, she and her children were evicted from their home. The little family lived in hotels until their money ran out then found shelter here at our Family Center.

(It’s sad but true: families like Cinda’s make up 50% of all homeless people in the Bay Area, and their numbers are growing each day!)

The family stayed with us for three months before they were able to find transitional housing. Unfortunately, that didn’t work out, and they were back at the Rescue Mission in January of this year.

“They give you encouragement and show you the Lord...”

Cinda is grateful for the help and hope the Rescue Mission offers. “When you don’t have family to go to, they give you encouragement and show you the Lord. Being here helped me rebuild and restore my relationship with Him!”

Providing a safe haven for as many as 325 homeless and needy men, women and children is a vital part of the Rescue Mission’s goal to help those in need build a brighter tomorrow. And that’s what Cinda is doing.

To get her out of the “revolving door” of homelessness, she’s taking classes in money management. Here at the Rescue Mission, she’s also in a more structured environment where

there are regular chores and a medical clinic for her and her children.

Other classes like computer training, life and family management skills and vocational training are available to guests like Cinda... classes that equip people who’ve been homeless to establish independent, self-sufficient lives.

Thanks to your support, all these services and more are available to the more than 35,000 homeless men, women and children in the Bay Area... helping families like Cinda’s build a brighter tomorrow!

“Wasting My Life...”

“I Was Existing to Drink”

Johnny will be the first to admit he had a “bad” alcohol problem. “I was really messed up. I had been drinking for over 30 years. I was no good to myself or my family.”

But God was watching over him – especially the day Johnny heard about the Bay Area Rescue Mission on the radio!

He kept “putting off” coming to the Rescue Mission until he became really sick and ended up in Highland Hospital. The staff there told Johnny he needed to get into a program. But even then, he resisted.

After detox, Johnny had “second thoughts.” Finally he entered our recovery program anyway but had a tough adjustment period. “I had the shakes, cold sweats, bad dreams...it was a real struggle, but thank God they have some good people here... people who knew how to help me get through what I was going through.”

“God was in the picture.”

Johnny will be the first to admit he wasn't a model patient. The first couple of months were a real struggle, but “God was in the picture.”

Eventually, life settled down. Johnny got in touch with his family in Alabama and told them he was in the program. “They were glad to hear that, and they've been supportive.”

“I had put God on the back burner,” Johnny says. “When I needed Him, I would call and He would come through. Then I would drink some more.”

Surviving on the streets makes people aggressive and “hard.” But today, Johnny is “softening,” and growing spiritually as he learns the basics of constant dependence on the Lord. With the help of our counselors and the encouragement of others in the recovery program, he's getting his life on track.

“I started this journey and I will finish it.”

Now that Johnny's mind is becoming clearer, he's rebuilding his life. “I'm writing my daughter. I even wrote my ex-wife an apology, letting her know

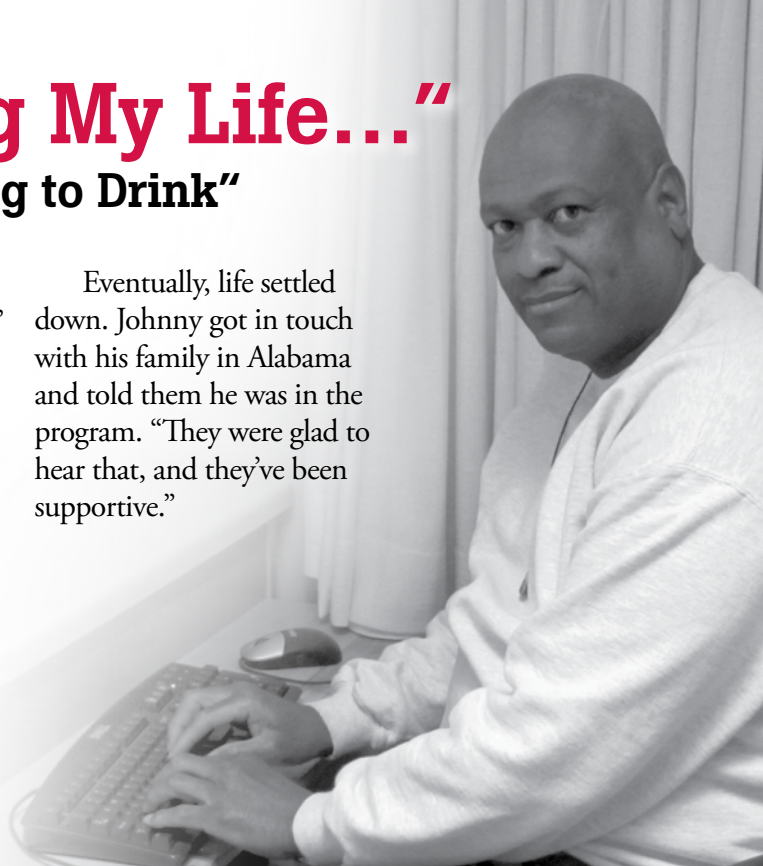
that she didn't do anything wrong. It was all me and how selfish I was.”

And, Johnny has finally taken God “off the back burner.”

“I was worthless to society, to myself, to my family, to everyone. But God was so patient.”

“When I really needed help, He got me to the Rescue Mission.”

Today, Johnny is well on “the right road” to a changed life. Instead of earning “just enough money to get drunk” and living on the streets or in abandoned houses, he's learning a job skill here at the Rescue Mission... helping other homeless and needy people who truly want to get back on their feet and reestablish their lives!
